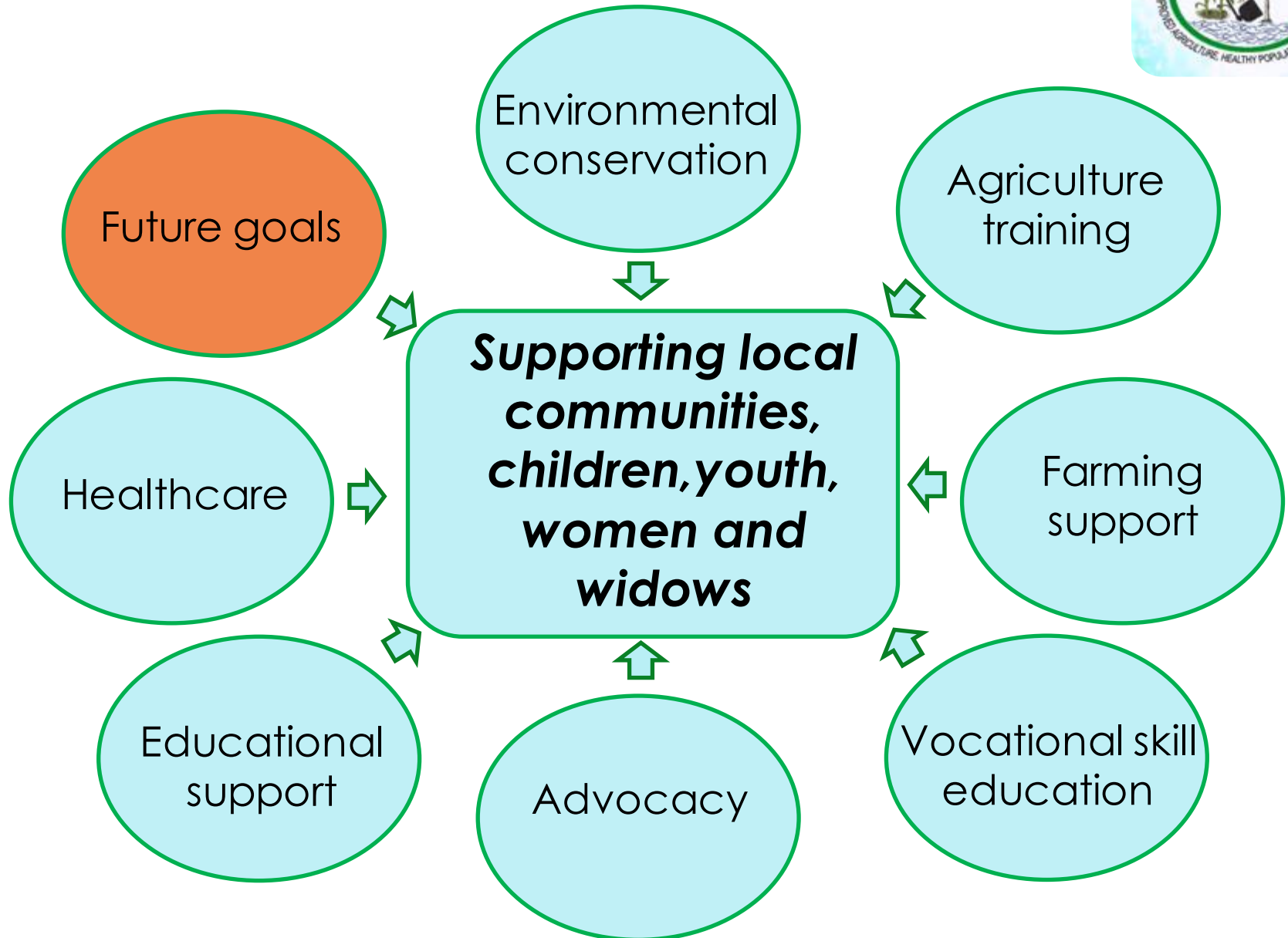

Environmental conservation

We are mostly working with
reusable energies and
teaching the locals how to
use these sustainable
methods, including:

- **Energy conservation**
- **Tree planting**
- **Energy saving cook
stoves**
- **Soil and water
conservation**



Agriculture training

We are educating vulnerable people about agriculture, including:

- Sustainable farming practices
- Protection from fungus and parasites
- Sterilizing and fertilizing the soil
- Proper seedling management
- Sack-gardening
- Kitchen gardening
- Nursery bed making
- Small-scale irrigation system making
- Small-scale water harvesting and storage



Farming support

We are supporting vulnerable people to start their farming activities by :

- **Providing draught resistant, highly productive seeds**
- **Providing poultry**
- **Providing equipment**

and helping them in:

- **Saving management**
- **Fungus and parasite problems**
- **Value addition**
e.g. tomato sauce and flour making



Vocational skill education

We are teaching out of school youth and widows how to:

- **Make books**
- **Tailor**
- **Style hair**
- **Bead**

We have training centers where we are using apprenticeship methods to teach:

- **Carpenters**
- **Builders**



Advocacy

Vulnerable people can't easily access services and often don't know about their rights. We are supporting:

- **Girl child advocacy**
- **Women in agriculture**
- **Child protection**
- **Protection against gender based violence**



Educational support

We are participating in the education of vulnerable children by:

- **Agriculture trainings**
- **Classes with volunteers**

And supporting them with:

- **Scolastic materials**
- **Education fees**



Healthcare

We are improving the local's poor health conditions by :

- **HIV/AIDS prevention and control**
- **Providing vitamins**
- **Health education**
- **Sexual reproductive health support**
- **Nutritional support and training**
- **Sanitation education and training**
