ACHIEVEMENTS FOR THE SAN MARTINO PRIMARY SCHOOL

- We successfully ended second school term on 13th August 2022 and started well the third and final school term on 22nd August 2022.
- In second term, our children performed better than first term with average mark of 62% compared to 54% in first term.
- With your support, 150 children got back parkers and are now safely carrying their books. All the 380 children also received; pencils, pens and mathematical sets.

NB: One of the children was so happy to the mathematical sets and said “ I had never owned a set, this is the first one”.

- We received study materials and colors for children in lower classes.
- We got some food and children are being fed. However, corn and beans are very expensive. We are unable to provide porridge at break time. We are only giving corn bread (posho) and beans for lunch.
- We hold monthly meetings and I also hold individual meetings. I have held successful meetings with Sue, Sarah Potter and Kristan. I want to thank them so much.

Other Achievements

- We got support for a dormitory and has been constructed up to the wall plate. We still need \$3000 to; roof it, fix windows and doors, and plaster . This is our focus this giving Tuesday.
- We have received Equipment for solar. Installation of the solar system starts next week
- We have received funds for getting a reliable water source (underground well). Construction starts next week too.
- We have 7 goats now and they are doing well. The boar is serving community goats too.
- We have eight bee hives now and they are also doing well.

School structures

- We have seven classes with an administration Block. The classes are well plastered inside and the outside is not plastered.
- We have a total of eight toilets. Six toilets are for the children. Two toilets for the teachers are also shared with class six, five and four
- We have a kitchen which is temporary. We use fire wood to cook.

- There are two teachers that share a room at our cottages.
